




THE GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM - GPS.

 Excellent course for younger kids. Lots of chances to have interaction and participation.







- U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, in cooperation with the American Canoe Association.








- Geared to a more adult audience.

- Earns the boater safety ID card.






